Background on Participating in the Match

- ❑ NRMP threshold is 75% of programs and 75% of slots are required to be in the match (the NRMP allowed us to enter with 70% of slots for the first year).
- ❑ Geriatric Medicine does not historically fill all ACGME accredited positions.
- ❑ In 2011, after discussions with NRMP, we determined that GM needed to understand how many positions program directors are actively trying to fill.
- ❑ Our reaching the threshold was calculated based on available slots of 439.

Where does the Data Come From?

- Surveys (gathering interest in Match)
 - 2010 Survey (150 programs, 130 responses)
 - 2011 Survey (145 programs, 132 responses)

- 2012-2013 Match Registration Data

- 2014 Post-Match Survey
 - still open, 145 programs, 122 responses
 - 47 slots represented by non-responding programs
 - 168 slots un-filled as of today by programs that responded

***2014 data is through April 30, 2014 and represents data collected from the Match and from the 122 programs responding to the post-match survey. Available slots for 2014 increased to 455 based on responses to the post-match survey.

Available Slots & Our Fill Rate

- Based on the data, geriatric medicine has filled an average of 285 slots per year since 2011.
- This is consistent with data from the surveys conducted by Gregg Warshaw and Libbie Bragg.

Slots Filled Outside the Match (as of 4/30/14)

- Programs have filled 114.5 Slots Outside of the Match.
- The only data we have on specific timing of when a Slot outside the Match was filled is those Slots filled by Programs that were All In:
 - 25 Slots were filled after the Match by programs that were All In
 - 45 Slots were filled by Programs that were All Out
 - 44.5 Slots were filled by Programs that were Some Slots In and Some Slots Out

Breakdown of Costs to Participate in the Match for 2015/2016 Cycle

Institution/Program Fees

- ❑ Institution registration: \$210 – regardless of the number of programs/tracks in the match
- ❑ Program registration: \$40 per program/track
- ❑ Matched applicant fee: \$40 per applicant

Applicant Fees:

- ❑ Applicant registration: \$65
- ❑ Couples: \$15 per partner

Summary Slide

- ❑ 239.5 slots are filled; a 53% fill rate when calculated on available slots (455)
- ❑ 125 slots were filled in the Match and 114.5 slots were filled outside the Match
- ❑ We have reached 84% of historical number of slots filled (285)
- ❑ Survey respondents are still actively seeking to fill slots (168) and 22 non-respondents represent 47 slots.
